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This APP is intended for all lovers of mountain hiking. And precisely for all those who do not see hiking as an athletic or sporting feat, but also as an opportunity for learning more about the history and culture of our territory.

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APP TALKING TRAILS



The "Talking Trails" application is an excellent instrument for consulting even off-line, when you have good coverage from your telephone operator; otherwise it always works only if the contents of the chosen itinerary have already been downloaded. Consulting the texts and images and listening to the Audio Guide is a useful way of preparing for your trip: if you know the itinerary in advance, as well as the historical and geomorphological features and the landscape that surrounds the trail you have chosen, you will have greater motivation for your plans.

The Application has some reserved functions for the preparation and safety of your trip. It has a check list of equipment "not to forget", suitable for the chosen itinerary; this will be an excellent memory aid to consult before you leave; a list of ruins taken from the Montagna Amica & Sicura project by CAI - Veneto Region: this will tell you what to do as a precaution and how to behave along the trail so as not to have unpleasant surprises or unforeseen circumstances that could threaten your safety.

1. PREPARE YOUR TRIP AT HOME

USEFUL ADVICE FOR SETTING OFF SAFELY

- 1) Start with a fully charged battery;
 - 2) Turn off all other applications opened in the background;
 - 3) Listen to the audio guide with the earphones, this keeps your attention on the path and limits the energy consumption of the screen.
- If you need to read the contents or view the photos in the App, you must stop in a safe place until the operation has not been completed. It is also suggested to bring the battery charger in the backpack, it may be useful while stopping at the Huts on the path.

1. From the thematic itineraries available select the one you want to follow and check if possible while still at home, that your "backpack" is ready with all its virtual contents.
2. When you reach your starting point, access the information for accident prevention, it will be useful for helping you follow the chosen trail in safety.
3. Now set off on the "talking trail" you have chosen.
4. At each stop (point of intersection or observation), for which you will receive an acoustic warning, choose how to access the contents: reading or listening (with headphones).
5. **WARNING:** In order to ensure the maximum battery life of your Smartphone for the time required to complete the chosen footpath, you should:



1. KAISERJÄGER



It is an excellent panoramic point over the whole area of Falzarego - Valparola, from which it looks down on the Sass de Stria and the military outposts of Vonbank and Goiginger below.

2. LAGAZUOI PICCOLO PEAK



It is an observation point a few minutes from the Lagazuoi Hut (2752 m). Access to the peak allows us to extend considerably to the west the already large view that can be enjoyed from the terrace of the hut; the panorama is spectacular, offering an all-round view of all the Ladin Dolomites of the neighbouring Valleys.

3. FORCELLA LAGAZUOI



It is hewn out of reddish and grey clay; it is the pass between the valleys of Falzarego and Sarè and it separates the Lagazuoi Piccolo from the Lagazuoi Grande. It is an important crossroads for hikers:

- trail no. 20/A
- trail no. 401
- Lagazuoi Hut

4. FORCELLA GRANDA



It is the northernmost turning point on the loop itinerary of Lagazuoi Grande. Broad and sloping gently towards Val Travenanzes (east), the pass presents towards Valone di Lagazuoi (west) a series of narrow gullies of debris, alternating with crumbly rock faces.

5. FORCELLA TRAVENANZES




The Val Travenanzes is the Park's wild valley par excellence, with no roads, no huts and a primeval beauty; it is a glacial valley, with an almost flat bottom and harsh, subvertical slopes.

The grasslands and the peat bogs of the upper part disappear farther down, swelled up by the mugo pine groves and the debris flows; towards the confluence with the Val di Fanes, the Val Travenanzes becomes more and more narrow and deep.

6. FORCELLA COL DEI BOS



As well as being of natural interest, the area of Forcella Col dei Bòs is rich in history, as it was a key point for the events of the Great War; among the most significant remains, besides the numerous fortified masses and trenches, there is the long mine tunnel of Castelletto, which is equipped and can be visited.



7. COL DEI BOS ROAD (TUNNEL)



The Col dei Bòs's military road is in a particularly favourable zone for various observations of flora and fauna, considering that the southern slopes of the To-fana di Ròzes and the Col dei Bos are among the richest for biodiversity in the Ampezzo Dolomites.

8. OSPEDALETTI OF FALZAREGO TOWER



Col dei Bòs and Cima Falzarego were a terrain of combat during the First World War; the field hospital for the wounded on the front was located at the base of the sheltered south slope, in the hollow under the Falzarego Tower. Sheltered from landslides and avalanches and reached by a winding road, the "Ospedaletti" still have some well preserved masonry structures.
